# Scholarships & Grants (Free Money)

## Scholarships (Merit)

- **UD Merit Scholarships**
  - Awarding is competitive and scholarship names and amounts vary
  - Renewable if students meet terms and conditions of awards
  - Additional info at [udel.edu/finance](http://udel.edu/finance)
- **Outside Scholarships**
  - Students must search opportunities
  - Check various clubs, organizations, free search engines, state higher education agencies

## Grants (Need)

- **University Grants**
  - Selection based on combination of financial need (as determined by the FAFSA) and strength of application
  - Funding renewable provided students meet terms and conditions of awards
  - Additional information at [udel.edu/finance](http://udel.edu/finance)
- **Federal Grants**
  - Pell/SEOG awarded to families with lowest Expected Family Contributions on FAFSA
  - Renewability requirements come from federal government

# Education Loans (Requires Repayment)

## Student Loans

- **Federal**
  - Requires FAFSA submission
  - \$5,500 max for first year students
  - Subsidized portion – need-based (interest paid by government while student in school)
  - Unsubsidized portion – not need-based (interest paid or added to balance at repayment)
- **Private**
  - Available from a variety of lenders
  - Must pass credit check
  - Students generally need creditworthy cosigner

## Parent Loans

- **Federal**
  - Requires FAFSA submission
  - Maximum is full cost of attendance less student aid
  - Must pass credit check





# Work-Study

- Based on financial need (requires FAFSA)
- Students work on or around campus for paycheck
- Can be used to cover expenses
- Students can request if not on award

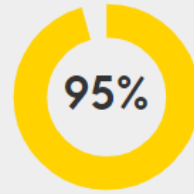
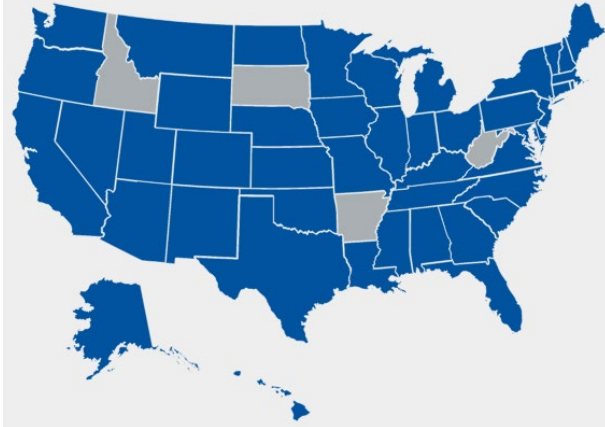
