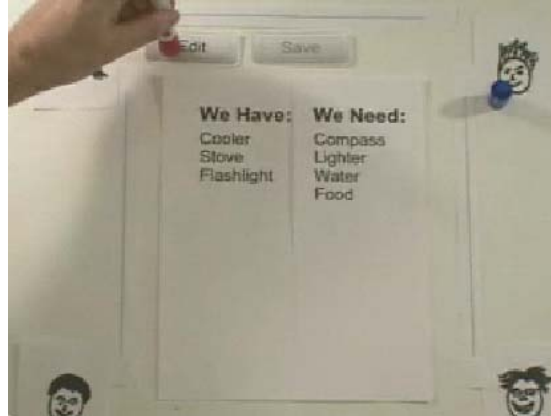



Use the History tab to revert to a previous version of the page.



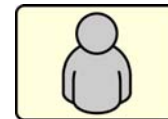

- Usability issues may occur.



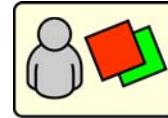
