General Information

- Brassica oleracea var. botrytis, Cauliflower
- Brassicaceae family
- Sunlight: full sun. Light shade. Can tolerate light shade but will slow maturity.
- Soil conditions: requires well-drained soil. Prefers fertile soil high in organic matter,
- Needs plentiful, consistent moisture.

- Orange- Flame Star (62 days)
- Purple Graffiti (80 days)
- Romanesco Puntoverde (78 days)


Common Pests and Diseases
