General Information

- Cucumis melo, Melon
- Cucurbitaceae family
- Sunlight: full sun.
- Soil conditions: fertile, well-drained soil.
- Can be grown on a trellis.

Successful Cultivators

- Sugar Cube (80 days) (Cantaloupe)Deep orange flesh. Some disease resistance.
- Honeycomb (78 days) (Honeydew) Smooth cream-colored skin, iy green flesh.
- Lilly (90 days) (Crenshaw) Oblong, light yellow skin, light orange flesh.

Common Pests and Diseases

- Squash bugs
- Squash vine borers
- Striped cucumber beetle (pictured here)
- Downy mildew
- Powdery mildew
