General Information

- Capsicum annuum, Pepper
- Solanaceae family
- Sunlight: Full sun.
- Soil conditions: well-drained fertile soil.
- Bell (pictured here), sweet, and hot varieties.

Successful Cultivators

- California Wonder (75 days) 4" heirloom, bell type.
- Jalapeno Early (75 days) Dark green, pungent, hot pepper. Hot type.
- Sweet Banana (72 days) 6-7" yellow fruit, matures to orange and red.

Common Pests and Diseases

- **Aphids**
- Flea Beetle
- Bacterial Spot
- Blossom End Rot (pictured here)
